



## Denver Kappa Friendship Fund, Inc.

**DKFF Scholarship Applications will be open from October 1<sup>st</sup> – November 12<sup>th</sup>.**

The Denver Kappa Friendship Fund (DKFF) is a 501(c)3 organization dedicated to providing financial support to Denver metro area Kappa Kappa Gamma alumnae, actives and local philanthropies that fall within Kappa Kappa Gamma's national philanthropic focus.

Scholarships in the amounts of **\$1000 - \$3000** are available for Kappa actives at Colorado State University, University of Colorado Boulder, University of Wyoming and those Kappa actives who are residents of the Denver Metro area but attend an out of state school. Applicants must have at least two semesters of verifiable GPA. Scholarships are awarded based on academic achievement, Panhellenic and community involvement, and financial need. Scholarship applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis, without regard to religion, race, or ethnicity.

The DKFF Board is now using Google Forms. This format does not allow data to be saved or the ability to preview the information requested. We suggest having the following information readily available to complete or upload to the application. You will also need to be signed in to your Google account to access the scholarship application.

1. Recommendation from a Kappa Chapter Advisor or University Academic Advisor or Professor (no peer references). (PDF Format).
2. Personal Essay stating educational and career goals as well as financial need. The essay should also state how you intend to use DKFF Scholarship. Essay must not be longer than 2 pages double spaced with 12 pt font (PDF format).
3. Cumulative GPA (GPA must be verifiable with your university).
4. Unofficial transcript (PDF Format).
5. Academic/Campus organizational honors (college only).
6. Describe any plans to study abroad, or participate in an internship or cooperative education(co-op).
7. Kappa chapter activities and leadership positions held.
8. Campus activities and leadership positions held (including Panhellenic organizations).
9. Community/volunteer activities.
10. Employment history, including all internships. Include employer, position/responsibilities, dates worked, and hours per week.

11. Financial assistance list scholarships and other financial assistance received. Include amounts and dates, and indicate if the assistance is renewable or not. Be sure to include any Kappa Kappa Gamma Foundation Scholarships and grants.

12. Describe any special family financial circumstances that impact the ability to provide for your education (i.e. support of an elderly relative, health problems, employment problems, etc).

13. Tuition and fees per year.

14. Room and board per year.

16. Other estimated educational costs (book, etc).

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Scholarship winners will be notified in January 2024.
